

AROUT CMDR

The Centre for Multi-Disciplinary Development Research (CMDR), Dharwad is an autonomous social science research institute sponsored by Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR) and also funded by Government of Karnataka. The Institute has been focusing developmental issues like health, education, environment and problems confronting the socially and economically marginalized sections of society. The Institute has done pioneering work in the area of economics of education, health, tobacco, natural resource accounting and health accounts. The Institute has been researching on these developmental issues from a wider multi-disciplinary perspective. The faculty members of the institute also have diverse academic backgrounds and are drawn from disciplines such as, economics, various anthropology, environmental studies, political science and so on. The researchers at the Institute have tried judiciously to combine the theoretical and empirical components into their research work.

Recently, the Government of Karnataka has accorded grant to establish Dr. D M Nanjundappa Chair (to study the regional imbalance in Karnataka) and Shri Abdul Nazir Saab Chair (to undertake research in Panchayat Raj System).

The institute has flourished in the ambience of educational institutions and has taken upon the task of 'capacity Building' in social science research, especially in the neighbouring areas. The Institute is unique in also translating the 'academic research' into 'action research', especially for the deprived sections of society at the grass root level.

CAPACITY BUILDING ACTIVITIES OF CMDR THROUGH TRAINING PROGRAMME

One of the main objectives of the Centre is to serve as a Think-Tank for the researchers and policy makers through its various targeted capacity building programmes and also publications. The Centre has been striving to fulfill this objective since its inception. Center has conducted various courses with different themes and variety of modules. ELIGIBILITY FOR THE COURSE

The participants should be Post Graduates in Social Sciences, registered for their Ph.D. or researchers who are interested in carrying out research projects may also apply.
