The entire abstract including text, figures, equations, structures, schemes and references must be sent as a word document (authorname.doc). The printed areas should be 5.6 inches (width) x 9.7 inches (length). Size of the Poster: 1.2 m height x 0.9 m width. Abstract should be sent to crisponduni@gmail.com before Nov.15, 2011.

It recognizes and honors scientists working in different areas of chemistry through awards, medals, grants, etc. The year 2011 is being celebrated as the International Year of Chemistry (IYC 2011) and, as part of this celebration, CRSI is organizing several activities at different places across the country, including four zonal meetings to promote chemical research and chemical education. The first zonal meeting was held at the National Chemical Laboratory, Pune and the two subsequent meetings were held at North Bengal University, Siliguri and Jammu University, Jammu. The purpose of this meeting is to provide a forum for scientists, teachers and students from the southern region to participate and discuss the recent developments in chemical sciences.
