Papers presented in the Seminar/Convention shall be considered for publication. The delegates are advised to submit their full paper(s) in the format of the Journal of IAS to the convener before 20th Dec. 2012.

YOUNG SEDIMENTOLOGISTS AWARD

The Indian Association of Sedimentologists introduced the Young Sedimentologists Award to encourage young researchers who are below 35 years (as on 1st July 2012) for the best paper presentation during the Seminar/Convention. The paper with single authorship only will be considered for the award. Prospective authors should submit a date of birth certificate duly attested by the Head as proof for age consideration. The last date for submission of full paper for consideration of Young Sedimentologists Award is 30th Nov, 2012. The Young Sedimentologists Award competition is open only to IAS members duly enrolled before 30th Nov 2012. A panel of experts will select, laying emphasis on the content of manuscript (25%), documentation (25%), presentation (25%) and defense (25%), the best amongst the contestants based on the oral presentation. The presentation shall be of 20 minutes duration and 10 minutes for defense.

ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

ABOUT PONDICHERRY (PUDUCHERRY)


Pondicherry is situated on the Coromandal coast, 160 km south of Chennai. It has the rich traditions of French, Anglo-Indian cultures with an aerial extent of 293 sq. km. The intellectual activities are fostered in many of its institutions such as Sri Aurobindo Ashram and the French Institute which caters to research needs in Science. Indology and Culture, Geologically, the U.T. of Puducherry is underlain by the semi-consolidated and unconsolidated sedimentary formations ranging in age from lower Cretaceous to Recent, lying on Archaean basement. The sediments are mainly clay, claystone, silt, siltstone, marl, limestone, sand, sandstone and gravel. The climate of Pondicherry is humid with mean temperature ranging from 25°C to 33°C. The summers are hot during March to April and winters during December to January are pleasant with minimum temperatures of 21°C. The normal annual rainfall is 1205mm with a maximum rainfall (650 mm) during North-East Monsoon (Oct to Dec).

CONVEYANCE

By Air: The nearest Airport is Chennai.

By Train: Pondicherry is connected by an electric broad gauge railway line through Villupuram. There are two trains from Chennai i.e Chennai Egmore - Puducherry Aurovile express and Chennai Egmore- Pondicherry fast passenger that runs daily. Trains from other places on weekly basis are New Delhi-Puducherry Express. Mangalore Express, Yeshvantpur Express, Howrah- Pondy express, Bhubaneswar-Pondy Express,

By Road: Pondicherry is well connected from all sides by roads. There are two routes from Chennai to Pondicherry, Route A: via NH 45, Route B: via ECR (East Coast Road). Express buses are available in 5 minutes frequency & A/C Volvo coaches in 1 hour frequency from CMBT (Chennai Mofussil Bus Terminus) at Kovambedu in Chennai (Platform 1, 2 & 3).
