Typewritten/ Manuscripts will be acceptable only in the following format-

- A 4 size page
- '1.5' line-spacing throughout the text
- Normal margins in all sides
- Page number on the bottom of the page consecutively
- Arial font with '12' font size.
- Abbreviation in the text with long names at the first mention
- For scientific studies, full Scientific Names and italics (genus, species, and authority, and cultivar where appropriate) at the first mention and abbreviated from second times onward.
- Long paper should not exceed 25 pages and short ones 12 pages (including all text, figures, references & appendices).
- Submissions should be made electronically in MS word via email or paper submission gateway of the journal.
- References- Latest Modern Language Association (MLA) style of citation and references.
