A graduate in MBE has great career prospects. You could serve as consultants, resource economists, policy advisors or analysts in a number of public and private sector organizations. Research in the area of economics is also a prospect you could look into. You could even opt for a job in the banking or financial sector. Consultancy, advertising and retail are also options- depending on your strengths, capabilities, and your liking.

Business Economist: They work with various industries and firms and their main work is to act as an intermediary between the firm and the outside world.

Asset Manager: He/she has to assist in managing the asset portfolio of the company, taking care of the third-party lease agents and engage in financial analysis and market study.

Credit and Risk Manager: They evaluate the financial data of the company and measure the default risk associated with it to help the lender as well as the buyer.

Market Analyst: A Market Analyst analyses the market so that their employers can make a better decision with respect to product launching or rendering services.

Operations Manager: An Operations Manager controls all day to day activities in the firm from production to analyzing statistics to training new employees. He has to make sure the organization is running at an optimal level.

Equity Research Analyst: An Equity Researcher is gathering information on equities for the purpose of investment and seeking the knowledge of the stock market as to where invest or whether to continue in the market or sell out.
