In particular, researchers are now told that they must not only publish their research, but also get their publications acknowledged by other researchers and society at large. In practice, this means that researchers need to get their publications (a) cited in the work of other researchers, and (b) discussed in traditional and on line media. To help achieve a greater scholarly and public impact, researchers must promote and advertise their work as much as possible. Publishing research article is an important indicator of successful operational research at programme level in low-income countries. In academia, publishing in peer-reviewed scientific journals is highly encouraged and strongly pursued for academic recognition and career progression. In this respect, the present workshop will lead the participants on the right path of academic publication and growth. Its objectives are:-

- to familiarize the importance of publication among the research scholars and young faculty.
- to explain the sources of data availability from different channels to prepare, research articles,
- to enlighten the components of research articles in the present scenario and
- to inculcate the art of preparing/publishing research articles.
