Government of Puducherry, Department of Tourism, is organizing a quiz competition for school and college students as a part of the "Paryatan Parv - 2019" celebrations. This competition is to be held for School Students (Class 8 and above), and for College Students. The school quiz and the college quiz are the two categories in this competition. The details of the same are given hereunder:

- Venue of the Competition : Art & Craft Village, Murungapakkam, Pondicherry – 605004
Date : October 3, 2019 (Thursday)
Time for Schools : 9.30 to 9.45 AM (registration & seating of teams)
9.45 to 10.30 AM (written preliminaries)
10.30 to 11.00 AM (snacks, followed by result of prelims)
11.00 to 1.00 PM (Semi-Final and Final Quizzes)
Time for Colleges : 1.00 to 1.15 PM (registration & seating of teams)
1.15 to 2.00 PM (written preliminaries)
2.00 to 2.30 PM (snacks, followed by result of prelims)
2.30 to 4.30 PM (Semi-Final and Final Quizzes)
Teams : Please send participants in teams of 2 members each. A maximum of only 6 teams per school/college (12 students) only.
Stay till the end (School student) : All the school participants must stay for the full duration of the programme. Register your team only if you are willing to be there till the end. Students will be allowed to leave only after the final quiz gets over at 1PM, to ensure uniformity and their safety.
Topics : The topics of the quiz are as follows:
1. Life & Works of Mahatma Gandhi (Major topic)
2. Places related to Mahatma Gandhi - then and now.
3. Tourism (India and Puducherry)

- Preliminary Round : A Written preliminary selection will be conducted to select the best teams for the oral finals.
- Semi-finals : All the schools and colleges which register with the maximum permitted strength of 12 students (6 teams) will be given representation in the oral semi-finals. In case the school/college sends less than 12 students, semi-final representation will be given only if the best team from the school/college is ranked among the top 12 teams (overall).
- Prizes and Certificates : Teams that are not selected are not compelled to wait after the results of the preliminaries are announced. However, if they choose to wait, they must remain till the end so that they do not disturb the conduct of the finals.
- Prizes and Certificates : All participants shall receive certificates, one week after the quiz is over. They will be sent to the schools/colleges.
- Prizes and Certificates : The top 3 finalist teams shall get attractive prizes as follows, in addition to merit certificates:
Winning team: School trophy + prizes + Individual (winners) trophies
Runners-up: Prizes + Individual (runners-up) trophies
3rd Prize: Prizes + Individual (3rd prize) trophies
4th to 6th: Prizes
- Prizes and Certificates : Schools/Colleges: All the participating schools and colleges will be given an "Institution Memento" and some books for the school library. In addition, all the participants of the quiz will receive attractive prizes and/or books & certificates.
- Prize distribution : The top 3 teams shall receive their prizes on the final day celebrations of Paryatan Parv - 2019 Tourism Festival. Other details about the venue and time of Prize Distribution will be intimated individually.
- Participation fee : No participation fee shall be collected
- Snacks : Will be provided to all participants after the prelims.
- Last Date : The application form enclosed along with should be filled & sent to us on or before the 30th of September without fail.

ADVANTAGES OF SENDING FULL STRENGTH

It is possible for an educational institution to send up to 12 students as representatives to the Paryatan Parv-2019 Quiz Competition. If they do so, there are a few additional benefits both to the institutions and the individual students, as follows:

- 1 All institutions which send the full strength of 12 students shall get representation on stage. The best team from each school/college which sends 12 students shall compulsorily be accommodated for the on-stage semi-final quiz. They will not go back empty handed without even attending the on-stage level quiz. Every team which qualifies for the on-stage level stands to win merit certificates.
- 2 If the institution sends 12 students (6 teams) to the Paryatan Parv Competition the institution shall receive Rs.3000/- worth of General Knowledge Quiz books for its library, within two weeks from the completion of the competition.
- 3 By sending 12 students, you can enable all the 12 of them to get certificates. These certificates are given by Tourism Department, Government of Puducherry and have a lot of face value. Certificates for all participants who do not qualify for the on-stage level shall be given within two weeks from the date of the competition (on or before Oct 16). However, merit certificates for the on-stage participants shall be distributed on the day of the prize distribution itself (Oct 7 or 8).
