

In such a vibrant climate, the responsibility to address the needs created by self-activating change lies at the door of educational leaders, classroom teachers, academic administrators, and community leaders. One efficient way to fulfill these needs is periodic curriculum revision. I believe that the ever-enhancing needs of various quarters of society and culture can be addressed effectively when inter-disciplinarity of the programs offered by the university can be complemented effectively by a robust mechanism to revisiting and revision of the curricula at regular interval of time.

In a recently held meeting of the Group of Secretaries on Education and Social Development with the Hon'ble Prime Minister, it was recommended that curricula of all academic departments in Universities should be reviewed and revised at least once in every three years. This review and revision of academic curricula should focus on the existing and potential demand and supply of skill sets to make the University/College students employable.

You are, therefore, requested to accord top priority to the matter and take immediate action so that the curricula of various programs offered at your university are revised and adopted for quick implementation by your University and the colleges affiliated to it.
