c) Margins: 1" on all sides (top, bottom, left, right) **d)** On every page, in the upper right margin (Header), ½" from the top and flush with the right margin put your last name followed by the page number. **e)** Title page is always the first page: On the line below the page number, the running head is typed flush left (all uppercase) following the words "Running head" **f)** Below the running head, the following are centred on their own lines, using upper and lower case: Paper Title, Your Name and Collaborators' name (if a collaborative work), Name of Institution/College/University and State.
