I	2012.70.03	Resolved to approve the establishment of a division of so skills training in the University with the suggestion the Professional Trainers be engaged for this purpose throug outsourcing.			
2	2012.70.04	Resolved to approve amendment to the clause 1.2 (b) of Ph.D. Regulation regarding admission of teachers working in Polytechnic Colleges as mentioned below: "Teacher candidates teaching in Recognized Schools at the High School level / Polytechnic Colleges situated within the jurisdiction of Pondicherry University and have put in at least 5 years of continuous teaching experience in the subject concerned".			
3	2012.70.09	Resolved to approve amendment to the clause 2.1 (i) of Ph.D. Regulation on the recommendation of the Academic Advisory Committee as detailed below: "Person with five years of industry experience, including in the field of media, who have a rich collection of data in their field and seeking admission to Ph.D part-time (external) are exempted from written entrance exam, but they have to give a seminar before the Admission committee which shall evaluate and recommend on the suitability of the candidate for admission to the Chairperson, Academic Council. While conducting the Seminar for such candidates, one external expert may be included in the Admission Committee, in addition to VC's nominee. Such candidates, not exceeding two, could be registered at a time in a Department". Such candidates should undergo the course work unless they have minimum two publications in the relevant area of research in standard refereed journals".			

		It was also resolved that a panel of experts shall be prepared for each subject to enable nomination of external experts by the Vice-Chancellor.
4.	2012.70.11	Resolved to approve the following recommendation of the academic advisory committee regarding the absence of students for NCC activities:
		"It was observed that under the existing rules 70% attendance is the minimum requirement for a student to appear in the examinations. Normally the absence on NCC activities should be covered in the remaining 30% absence permissible under the rules.
		In addition to the above, wherever required, further relaxation of attendance requirements not exceeding 10% may be allowed with the prior approval of the Head of the Department concerned, based on the attendance certificate given by the NCC Officer."
5.	2012.70.16	Resolved to approve the academic calendar for the University Departments and affiliated colleges for the academic year 2012-2013 (copy attached).
6	2012.70.19	Resolved to approve the proposal of transfer of Department of Coastal Disaster management from the School of life Sciences to the School of Physical, Chemical and Applied Sciences. The council also resolved to constitute a committee to review the courses offered in the department and suggest suitable restructuring.
7.	2012.70.29	Resolved to follow the existing practice of retaining the original certificates of the students at the Department after verification and admission process is completed.
8.	2012.70.30	Resolved to approve the regulations for Dual Degree Programme and Integrated PG - Ph.D. Programme at Pondicherry University from the academic year 2012-13 (copies enclosed)

PONDICHERRY UNIVERSITY

DUAL DEGREE ACADEMIC PROGRAM

Preamble:

The fast changing dynamics of Global economy has directly influenced the knowledge and skill requirement of human resources. The older concepts of focused fields of education in a particular subject or a branch of the subject has been replaced largely by inter disciplinary horizons of learning. But, this was possible, if a student takes two post-graduate programmes. For example, An MBA may need to take another PG degree in Commerce, Accounting & Taxation. An MTech in Electronics may have to take one more PG pragramme in VLSI. Several such a examples can be given which enhance the marketability of the student and also make him more useful on a larger canvas of industry's need. It was also found that PG four semester programmes in allied fields will have several papers common between them. Pondicherry University has, therefore, proposed the dual degree programme in allied subjects wherein the student takes advantage of the choice based credit system (CBCS) and does not necessarily study the 4 semesters for a second degree but completes it in two additional semesters by fulfilling the requirements of credits taking only those courses for which he/she has not studied.

<u>Definition</u>: Dual degree programme permits a student to seek admission and complete a second Master's degree without registering for courses already studied. This Program is proposed at Post-Graduate (PG) level under the Choice Based Credit System.

Regulations:

- Dual Degree is allowed only in the allied subjects and when the programme is being independently offered in the same Department/Centre or another Department/Centre.
- 2. These two programmes should have courses common to them with a minimum of 30 credits out of 72 credits (or 40 credits out of 100 credits).

- 3. The admission to dual degree shall be advertized in the prospectus each year after due approval of Academic and Executive Councils.
- 4. The dual degree shall be designed in such a way that (a) common courses are offered in first two semesters and (b) balance of credits in prescribed courses shall fall in the last two semesters (5 & 6) so that students of second degree can horizontally tow the 3rd semester along with the students of the main stream.
- 5. It is mandatory that dual degree should be pursued continuously and without any break unless the student has failed in some of courses taken in the third/fourth semester of 1st degree.
- 6. Students with discontinuation of one academic year or more are not eligible for admission to dual degree.
- 7. The intake to second degree under the dual degree programme shall be decided by the concerned department depending on the faculties and facilities available.
- 8. The Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of the 2nd degree shall be calculated based on the grades earned in the subjects common to both 1st and 2nd degrees and those earned in the prescribed courses of the 2nd degree.
- 9. Separate grade card and degree certificates shall be issued to each of the degrees covered under the Dual Degree program.
- 10. A student is entitled to get his/her first degree in the convocation without completing the second degree or he/she can apply for both the degrees at the end of 6th semester or when he/she completes both the degree courses.

Entrance Test:

- i) There shall be a common entrance for the admission to the first degree of the dual degree programme.
- ii) There shall be no separate entrance test for dual degree (2nd degree) for lateral entry. However, the admission is based on the CGPA earned in the 1st degree and shall be in the order of merit, with due reservations.

iii)	The Department shall notify the vacancies in the second Dual Degree at the time of issue of admission notification by the University.

PONDICHERRY UNIVERSITY

INTEGRATED PG - Ph.D. PROGRAM

Introduction

The concern of the nation has been about enhancing the quality of research in Universities, as well, as increase the number of students taking to research degrees and obtaining Doctoral degrees.

Integrated Ph.D. program gives unique opportunity to obtain Ph.D. degree within a shorter duration and is very useful to the students who plan to build their career in research or higher education. This program offers research orientation from the third semester onwards by giving specialized courses in the area of research the student plans to pursue. The fourth semester is entirely devoted to research project which could be a pilot or precursor to the Ph.D. research work. On completion of all the credit requirements the student enters into the part II of the program which is entirely research.

Part I: M. Sc. Credit Requirements

First three semesters of course work (3 sem x 18 cr)	54 credits
Fourth semester – Project work including viva-voce	18 credits
Total	72 credits

Part II: Minimum duration

The Ph.D. thesis can be submitted if the candidate has *at least* one paper written out of the research work published in standard refereed journal after two years duration. The progress of the scholar will be monitored by the Doctoral

Committee. The period for integrated PhD shall normally be 5 years extendable by one year in exceptional cases after due assessment of work by the Doctoral Committee.

Regulations

- 1) Students with a CGPA of 6 or more on completion of mandated credits at the end of 4 semesters are eligible to proceed to Part II of the Ph.D. program.

 Others will be eligible for award of PG degree if they have completed the credit requirements for that degree.
- 2) The student who has CGPA of 6 or more on completion of four semesters may be permitted to exit the program with the PG degree on successful completion of credit requirements for that degree, however, he or she shall refund the stipend of Rs.1000/- per month paid.
- 4) Evaluation and award of grades during first four semester will be governed by the CBCS regulations.
- 5) The students of integrated Ph.D. program may be advised by their faculty advisor to take additional courses in the same department or any other department in order to meet the deficiencies for pursuing PhD program.
- 6) The students admitted to integrated PhD program shall take courses of first three semesters together with the students of main stream Master's degree program.
- 7) A candidate joining the integrated PhD program shall get a monthly stipend of Rs.1000/- for four semesters (20 months) and Rs.5000/- per month for the next three years extendable by one year. During the Ph.D. period, the candidate is also eligible for contingency from UGC.

- 8) The successful candidate shall get two degrees after the award of Ph.D. degree namely, M.A. / M.Sc. / M.Tech., as applicable, along with the Ph.D. degree.
- 9) All other regulations for regular Ph.D. program also apply to integrated PhD program.
