### Access to International Monetary Fund (IMF) eLibrary

International Monetary Fund (IMF) eLibrary is a comprehensive, easy to use source of unrivaled research and statistics on financial and economic development. IMF eLibrary offers entire catalogue of more than 12,000 publications in several digital formats and the following IMF's premier statistical databases:

- **International Financial Statistics (IFS) Database**
- **Balance of Payment Statistics (BOPS) Database**
- **Direction of Trade Statistics (DOTS) Database**
- **Government Finance Statistics (GFS) Database**
- **Statistical Yearbooks**
- **Manuals and Guides**

IMF eLibrary has an interface that allows unified access to all databases which is located at <http://elibrary-data.imf.org>. The text is available at <http://www.elibrary.imf.org/>. Users can switch between data and text interfaces by using the links at top left of any screen.

With IP access, no sign in is necessary to view content. Access is automatically granted to anyone coming from a permissioned IP address. However, if individual users wish to save searches, results, download data or set alerts, they will need to set up a "personal" account. Any user can do this on their own (no action by the IMF or the account administrator is required) by clicking the 'Register' option on the data site and following the instructions. Users will only need to register their username and password once, and will be automatically logged in to all sites by using either the "Sign In" option on the data site or "Sign Up" option on the text site.
