ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

Although a plethora of studies call attention to the gendered vulnerabilities to natural disasters, in practice, little thought has been paid to both women's and men's needs and concerns during different phases of a disaster. Therefore, the broad debate of this proposed seminar is to interlink gender vulnerability to disasters. Basically, how does gender analysis help us to understand vulnerability? By and large, the disaster planners feel that gender is certainly not the only determining factor of vulnerability, nor is it always the most important. Nonetheless, understanding these linkages through gender analysis makes it clear that women are vulnerable not because it is in their physical nature to be weak but because of the arrangements of societies that result in their poverty, political marginalisation, and dependence on men. Furthermore, understanding that vulnerability is a condition caused by human actions and attitudes can provide insights about strategies for addressing vulnerability and thus dealing with the causes, rather than the symptoms of disasters.

It is in this context that this national conference is going to deliberate why and how disasters are a gender issue. It is important to acknowledge that disasters are not 'acts of God', but occur as a result of human decisions and actions. If women in informal settlements are the most vulnerable to the threat of disasters, what support do they need to become less vulnerable? What can we do to reduce their economic/social/health risk of such and such a community? Unless the planning of development programmes incorporates questions of gender, those most at risk from environmental factors will not benefit. **SUB-THEMES:**

- Perspectives on Gender and Disaster
- Gender Inequality, Susceptibility and Disaster
- Gender Violence, Masculinities and Disaster
- Impact of Disaster on Women
- Women's Vulnerability and Responses to Disaster
- Lessons Learned from History: Assessing Women's Preparedness, Recovery and Mitigation
- Women in Emergency: Case Studies from India and Beyond
- Understanding the Role of Men in Gender Equality and Disaster Risk Reduction
- Towards Gender Equality in Disaster Risk Reduction: Challenges for the Future
