CIRCULAR

It is informed that the PG Scholarship Committee meeting held on 14.03.2016 to look into the disparity among the Scholarship recommended the following scheme of scholarship.

Students admitted during 2015-16

(I) Merit Scholarship: (Applicable for 2 years PG Courses)

The first three candidates who secure the highest percentage of marks in previous semester will be awarded the Merit Scholarship @ ₹. 2,000, ₹. 1,500 & ₹. 1,000 p.m. respectively.

(II) Merit-cum-Means Scholarship:

40% of the students in each PG course are eligible for the award of MCM Scholarship of the University. The Scholarship is based both on the merit in each semester and the parental income of the student. The annual income of the parents should not exceed ₹. 2,50,000/- (Rupees two lakh fifty thousand only). Amount of scholarship is ₹. 750/- p.m. The existing 20% of freeship is merged with Merit cum Means Scholarship. This is applicable to all the PG students.

(III) Freeship:

The existing freeship to the first six students who are admitted in the Sanskrit and Hindi Programme will continue.

M.A Five year Integrated Courses

The Committee decided to extend the Scholarship of ₹.750/- p.m. to the Integrated M.A students of History, Sociology and Political Science. This is applicable to those who are on roll, in the first, second and third year of M.A 5 year Integrated Programme. They will continue to get the said scholarship till they complete the third year of the programme. This is effective from the academic year 2015-16. This is applicable to all M.Sc 5 year Integrated Programme.

Scholarship Scheme from Academic year 2016-17 onwards (P.G Courses/M.Sc & M.A Integrated Programme)

(I) Merit Scholarship:

(i) The first three candidates who secure the highest percentage of marks in P.G admission entrance examination shall be eligible for the award of Merit

- Scholarship @ ₹. 2,000, ₹. 1,500 & ₹. 1,000 p.m respectively for the first semester.
- (ii) For the subsequent semesters the Merit scholarship at the same rate of ₹.2,000, ₹. 1,500 & ₹. 1,000 p.m shall be awarded to the first three candidates who secured highest marks in the previous semester.

(II) Merit-cum-Means Scholarship:

20% of the students in each P.G degree programme are eligible for the award of MCM Scholarship of the University. The scholarship is based both on the merit in each semester and the parental income of the student. The annual income of the parents should not exceed ₹.2,50,000/- (Rupees two lakh fifty thousand only). Amount of scholarship is ₹. 750/- p.m.

(III) Freeship:

The first six students who join PG programme in Hindi and Sanskrit are eligible for award of freeship. The freeship would cover tuition fee for the course period.

The following existing conditions are applicable for the award of scholarship.

- (1) A minimum of five candidates should take up the entrance examination for admission and there should be a minimum of 5 candidates in the class, otherwise the candidates cannot be considered for award of scholarship.
- (2) For Merit Scholarship, the student should have scored 50% as minimum and 40% for Merit cum Means Scholarship in the entrance examination for award of scholarship for the first semester.
- (3) Semester GPA will be the criteria for award of Merit/Merit cum Means Scholarship.
- (4) In case of tie, it shall will be resolved by taking into account the marks in the previous semester (GPA)/entrance mark as the case may be.
- (5) Should secure atleast 70% attendance in every month.
- (6) Should pass in all papers registered for each semester.
- (7) The Head of the Department concerned shall certify in respect of the conditions.
- (8) The students are eligible for only one scholarship.

The above scholarships are subject to approval of the EC/AC and FC.
