PRIORITY AREAS FOR RESEARCH/EVALUATION STUDIES FOR THE YEAR 2011-12

Proposals are invited from reputed Institutions, which have capacity to do research on following Priority Areas of the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment.

Scheduled Castes Development:

1. **Evaluation of the Voluntary Organizations working for Scheduled Castes Development** in the following areas:-
 - (i) **Residential Schools** : In the States of Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh, Orissa and Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh and Tamil Nadu.
 - (ii) **Mobile Dispensaries** : In the States of Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh and Karnataka.
2. **Evaluation Study of National Safai Karamachari Finance & Development Corporation**

Eligibility Criteria:

Research/Evaluation proposals will be accepted **by registered post** only from the organisations/institutions/ universities/ NGOs who are conforming to the following criteria:-

- i) The Project Director should be at least Ph.D. with at least five years experience in the relevant field.
- ii) Institution conducting the study should be a reputed one and competent enough to conduct the study.
- iii) Research methodology should be clear and precise and should be a study on emerging trends.
- iv) All the organisations submitting proposals to carry out the study would be evaluated also on the basis of the quality of work done by them for the Ministry in the past.

The proposals should be forwarded by the Head of the Institute by Registered Post and in case of University by the Registrar of the University latest by 15th November, 2011 both hard as well as soft copy as per the guidelines of PREM Division, in this regard, available in the website - <http://www.socialjustice.nic.in>.
