ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

Over the past two decades, there has been a massive influx of women into the workforce in every region in the world. Greater numbers of women are involved in public services and an increasing number of countries are adopting equal opportunity policies to encourage and enable women to join the labour market. Yet, despite significant progress in education and access to decision-making posts, women's status in the workplace reflects neither their educational achievements nor their work experience. Indeed, women continue to face numerous obstacles to accessing the labour market and to progressing within it. Women almost everywhere still earn less than men for work of equal value; they have fewer opportunities to obtain better-paid jobs; and they still assume the lion's share of domestic responsibilities. Women face discrimination in the workplace based on assumptions about women's role in society and on what jobs are "appropriate" for women. In this backdrop the National Conference on Women and Work is organized by Centre for women studies, Pondicherry University in collaboration with Puducherry State resource centre for women.
