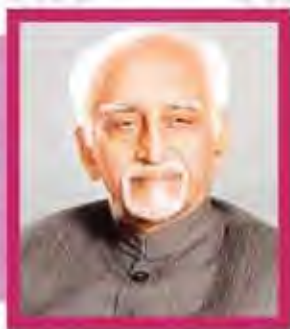

Demographic Diversity & Equity

The National character of this University was ensured by holding entrance tests in 39 Centres across the country including Jammu & Kashmir. The Women enrolment was increased through incentives such rent-free hostels. Physically Challenged students were encouraged through free education including free boarding & accommodation. Women faculty increased from 37 to 95. A substantial increase in the representation of SC, ST, OBC and Minorities both amongst faculty and students was achieved.

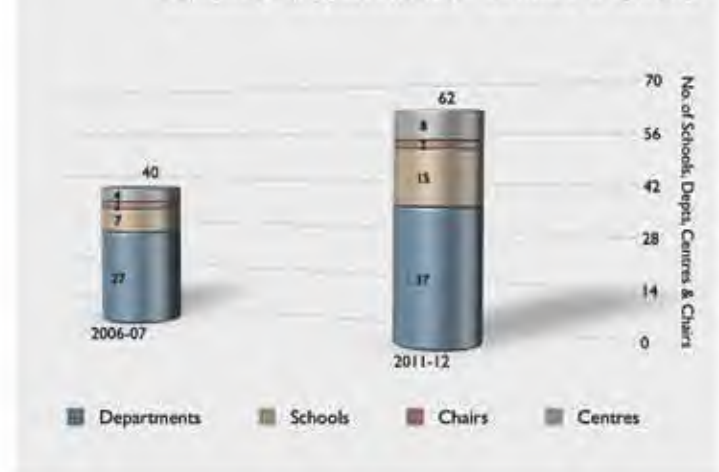

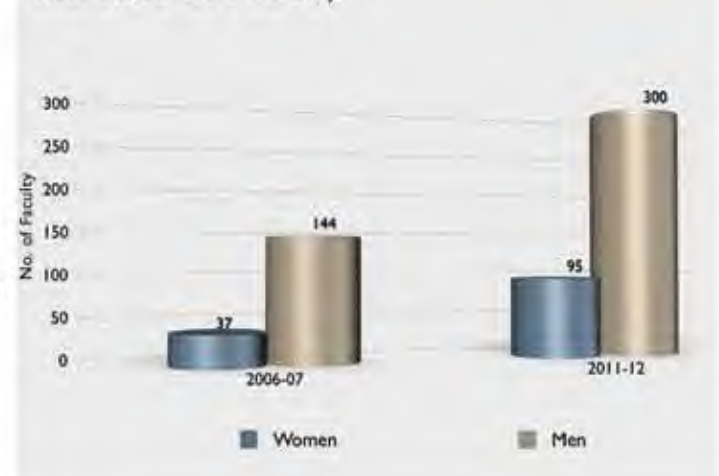
Establishment of Centres at Outlying Regions

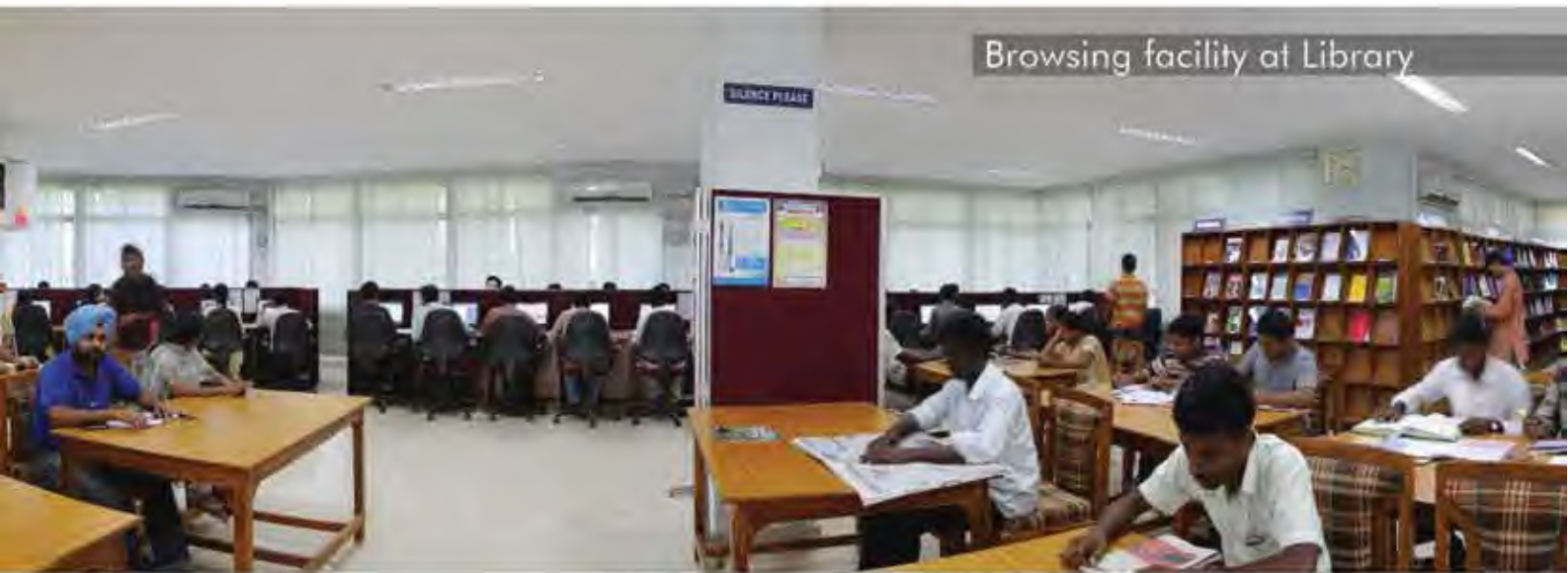

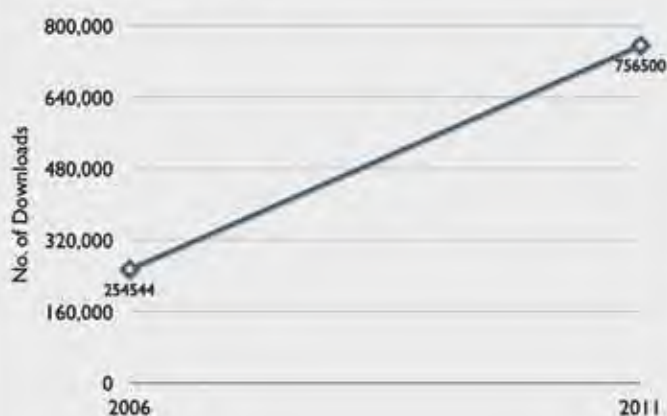

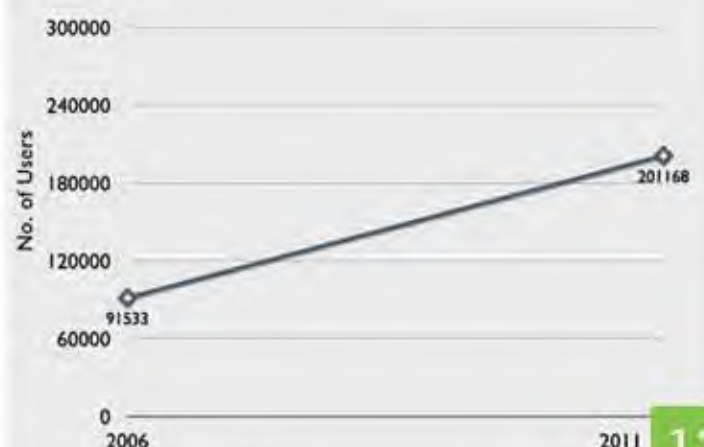

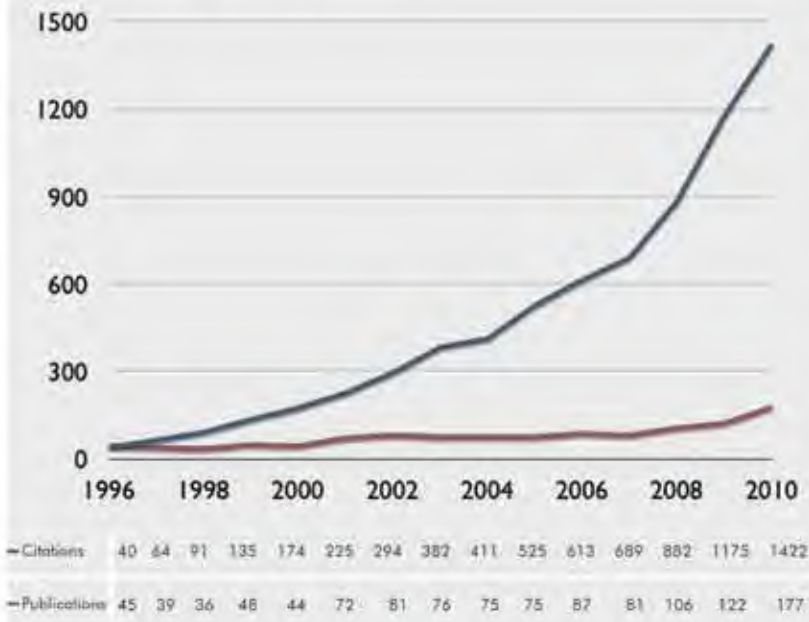

Research Publications & Citations in indexed Journals (Source : SCOPUS)

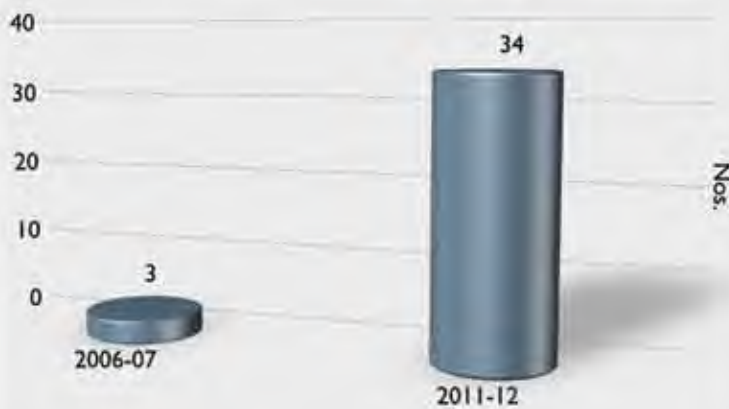

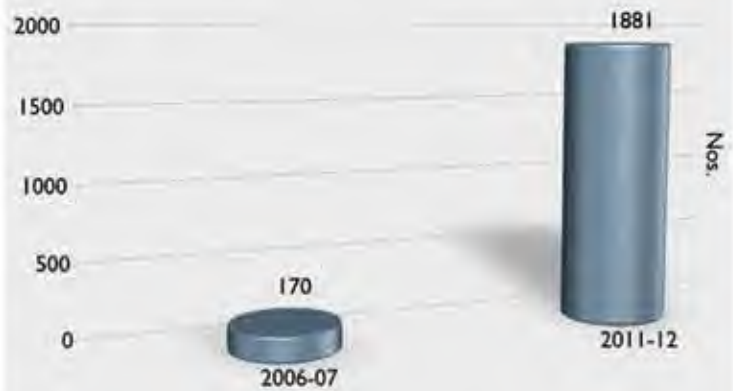

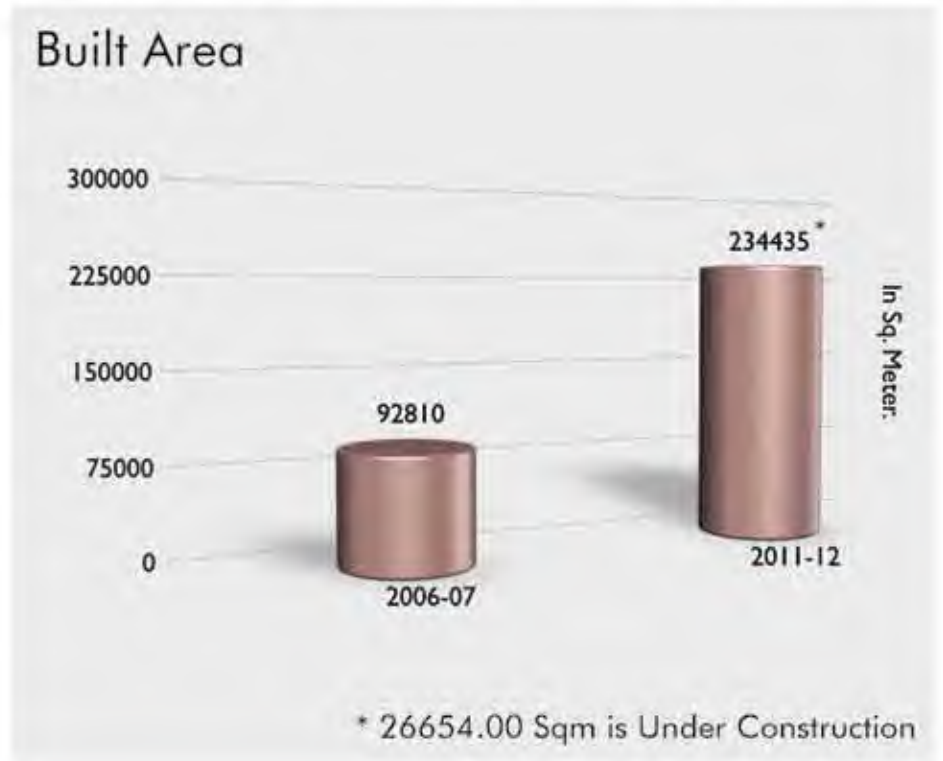

1.5 Million Sq. ft. Built Up Space Created

The creation of substantial space for all disciplines, independent blocks for every major department of Sciences, Social Sciences & Humanities, with an addition of built area of 1,42,000 sq. mtrs. in such a short time is unprecedented. The University has 2.2 Million sq. ft. of built-in area on a 780 acres Wi-Fi enabled campus.



Day Care Centre & Kindergarten

Realizing the anxiety of young mothers employed at the University, a state-of-the-art air-conditioned Day Care centre has been established. This is a free service of the University to young faculty which has increased their efficiency and output.



Community Radio

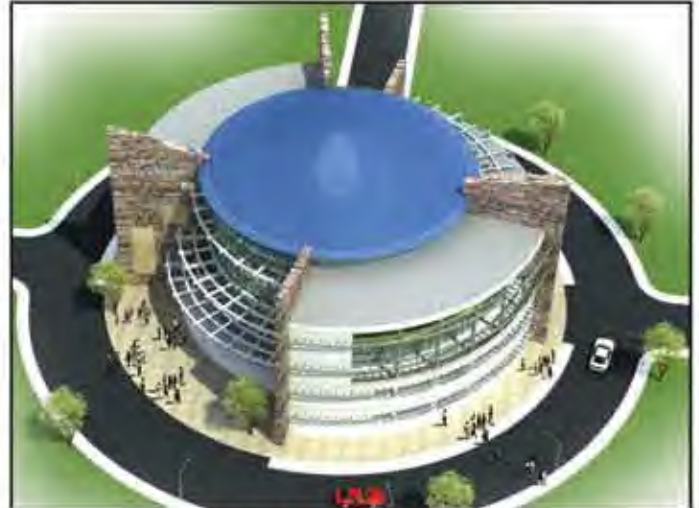

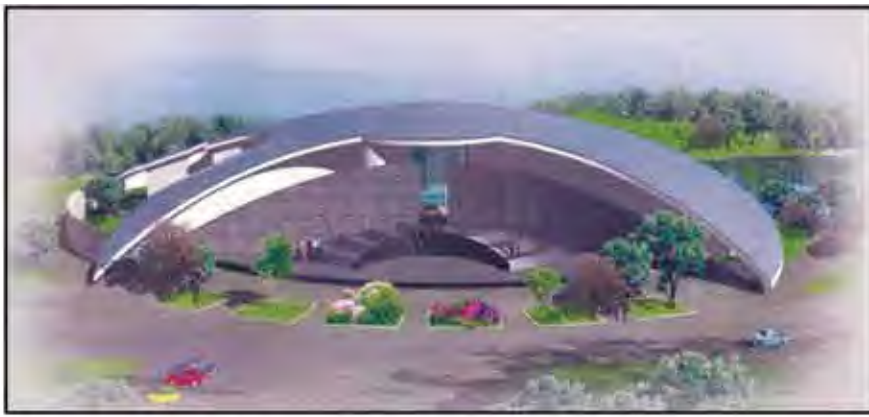
Centre for Bioinformatics

Library Annexe Building

With the increasing student strength, an Annexe Building of the Library is being constructed. This will have, besides stacks, a 24-hour Reading Hall, an exclusive state-of-the-art reference facility for the visually challenged staff and students and a Children's Library.
