CIRCULAR

The Death Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi, Father of Nation, will be observed as Martyr's Day on Monday the 30th January 2012. A two minute silence will be observed on that day between 11.00 a.m. and 11.02 a.m. in memory of those who sacrificed their lives in the struggle for freedom. To indicate the commencement of the two minute silence, a siren will be blown from 10.59 a.m. to 11.00 a.m. The siren will be blown again from 11.02 a.m. to 11.03 a.m. to indicate the end of the silence.

2. The Chief Executives of all the Mills located in the Puducherry Region are hereby requested to kindly arrange for the blowing of sirens located in the Mills as indicated in para 1 above. They are also requested to give suitable instructions to the workers and staff of their establishments to stand at their place of work on hearing the siren and to observe silence from 11.00 a.m. to 11.02 a.m. on 30.01.2012.
3. The Inspector General of Police is requested to arrange for the stoppage of vehicular and pedestrian traffic on the roads during the period of silence.
4. The Station Director, All India Radio and the Director, Doordarshan Kendra, Puducherry are requested to broadcast/teecast announcements in the Radio and Television in a suitable manner at frequent intervals for the information of the public to observe the silence from 11.00 a. m. to 11.02 a. m. on 30.01.2012.
5. The Registrar of Pondicherry University, the Director of JIPMER and Heads of all Central Government Offices and institutions located in Puducherry Region are hereby requested to issue suitable instructions to their staff for the observance of silence on Martyr's Day.
6. The Commissioner, Puducherry Municipality may arrange for the blowing of siren located in the Big Market area to mark the commencement and end of silence.
7. The Director of School Education / Higher and Technical Education are requested to issue instruction to all educational institutions in the Union Territory of Puducherry and Public Sector Enterprises under their control for observance of the Martyr's Day with full solemnity and in a befitting manner. Speeches and talks connected with the significance of the day, particularly mentioning the role of freedom fighters in the Freedom of India may be made. The theme of talks and speeches could also deal with the duty and the moral obligation of every citizen to preserve, protect and enrich the hard earned freedom and to promote a sense of national integration and commitment to common goals and ideals.
8. The Chamber of Commerce and industry in the Union Territory of Puducherry is requested to ensure proper observance of the Martyrs' Day by their members and affiliated associations and organizations.
