OBJECTIVES

The main objective of the course is to train the participating research scholars in the following aspects of research:

1. Research philosophy
2. Research design and inter-disciplinary research methods
3. Emerging research opportunities in social sectors
4. Theoretical approaches and ethical issues in social science research
5. Qualitative, quantitative and mixed research methods
6. Developing and presenting academic writings
7. Publishing research paper

ELIGIBILITY OF THE PARTICIPANTS

Registered/enrolled PhD research scholars of any Indian University/Institute/College in any branch of Social Sciences are eligible to apply in the prescribed application form. The candidates will be selected on the basis of (1) the strength of the concept note of their current work (in 1500 words mentioning title of the paper, abstract, problem, materials and methods, probable outcomes, implications/conclusions); and (2) A copy of their caste certificate. First timers would be given preference over repeat applicants.

HOW TO APPLY

Apply with the following documents:

1. Duly filled-in prescribed registration form which can be downloaded from www.gidr.ac.in
2. Self-attested copy of the caste certificate (SC/ST) issued by a competent authority.
3. A brief research note of the research work (maximum 1500 words mentioning title of the paper, abstract, problem, materials and methods, probable outcomes, implications/conclusions) Filled-in application with necessary documents should be sent to Dr. Jharna Pathak, Assistant Professor and Programme Coordinator, at sheela@gidr.ac.in by **29 January 2018**. Hard copies of these documents may be sent to the *Gujarat Institute of Development Research, Near Gota Flyover, Sarkhej Gandhinagar Highway, Gota, Ahmedabad – 380 060, Gujarat*. The participants will be selected on the basis of the merit of their research notes submitted along with duly filled-in registration form.
