(Altmetrics tool for Measuring research impact)

PlumXTM is an impact dashboard that provides evidence of how research output in all its forms is being utilized, interacted with, and talked about around the world. Harvesting metrics from a multitude of online sources, PlumX offers an exciting new way to see the influence of researchers, groups, and institutions. You no longer have to wait for years until the research is eventually cited before you gain any insight. Don't limit yourself to articles - PlumX tracks dozens of artifact types. Through summaries and visualizations of the data you can quickly see metrics never before available. You can also dive into the data using the PlumX toolset or export to it to the tools you currently use.

According to Plum Analytics, PlumX is one of the first altmetrics tools, which collects data from various forms of research, such as articles, books, datasets, clinical trials, figures, source code, videos, presentations and more. PlumX tracks more than 20 types of research forms.
