NASSCOM announces the revised launch of its NAC & NAC-TECH 2.0 a national level standard online competency assessment test conducted in association with its council member companies like CTS, TCS, Infosys, Wipro and Accenture.

The objective of this test is to standardize the fresher recruitment at campus level on pan India basis with one single test designed and endorsed by the TOP MNC'S. This would help both academia and the industry to expand their reach. While the challenge on industry side with increasing demand for talent acquisition search has been addressed by helping them to reach more campus at Tier-2 Tier-3 towns, the academia interest on providing equal employment opportunity for students in TPO MNC's from rural areas of our country has also been met.

This year so far about 35,000 engineering and Non- engineering students have taken the NAC & NAC-TEST and as anticipated the reception from rural areas have been very encouraging.
