6. Roshni Nilaya, School of Social Work Best Paper Award, for MSW/MA Social Work Student(s) in the field of Child Mental Health.
7. Dr. G. S. Udaya Kumar Memorial Best Paper Award, for a Social Work Practitioner in the field of Family Related studies.
8. Dr.M.Chandrasekhar Rao Memorial Best Paper Award, for M.Phil./Ph.D. Scholars in the field of Social Work Research

ISPSW BEST PAPER AWARDS-NORMS

1. All life members are eligible to contest for various awards.
2. Life Members are expected to contest only under any one category provided, they fulfil the requirements.
3. A member who has received award will not be eligible to contest the award for two consecutive annual conferences.
4. The first author only has to make presentation and he/she should be the Life Member of ISPSW.
5. The paper for consideration for award must reach to the e-mail id: secretaryispsw@gmail.com (In MS word file with their full contact details including mobile number).
6. Both hard and soft copies are to be submitted with a covering letter mentioning clearly the category under which the paper to be considered for award.
7. The paper to be considered for any award must be research based. The first author has to declare that the paper has not been published in any Journal /Magazine or presented in any other conferences or seminars.
8. There should be a minimum of two entries and two presentations in a category for contesting the award. In case there is only one paper under any category, the author will be allowed only to make presentation and the award will be deferred.
9. A three member committee consisting of ISPSW senior members and professionals from allied fields suggested by the Executive Committee of ISPSW shall evaluate the merit of each paper under the categories of different awards.
10. The evaluation includes the following components:
 - (a) Importance of study undertaken in the present context-20%
 - (b) Materials and Methodology adopted- 20%
 - (c) Presentation of Results – 20%
 - (d) Conclusion and Recommendations- 20%,
 - (e) Method of presentation and discussion followed-20%
11. The decision of the judges will be the final with the consent of the ISPSW.
12. Contestants and definition of terms:

Faculty: Faculty members working on full time/regular/ contract basis/ guest faculty in any recognized college/ university.

Social Work Practitioners: Social Workers working in both Government and NGO's in relevant field of social work.

Research Scholars: Scholars pursuing M.Phil. or Ph.D. on fulltime / part time basis

Student: First or Second year full time MSW/M.A (Social Work) students from a regular college/ University

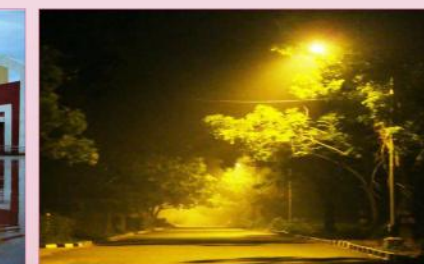

HOW TO REACH PONDICHERRY UNIVERSITY

The Pondicherry University is located at about 165 km south of Chennai metropolitan city. It is well-connected by road and rail. Pondicherry University is situated on the Chennai-Puducherry East Coast Road (ECR). The buses ply frequently from Chennai to Puducherry on the ECR route and stop readily on request at, opposite to Pondicherry University Gate - 2. From Chennai, this is the most convenient route to reach the University. However, from Chennai, Puducherry can also be reached by NH 45 via. Tindivanam and one should get down at Puducherry Bus Stand and then take a city service to reach the University. From other southern towns and cities like Bengaluru, Tiruchirapalli, Madurai, Coimbatore, Trivandrum by road, one should get down at Puducherry Bus Stand. By train, one has to get down at Puducherry Railway Station and reach Bus Stand in order to catch a town bus to reach Pondicherry University. The Pondicherry University is located at about 11 kms north of Puducherry Bus Stand and can be reached by town bus/auto rickshaw/taxi.
