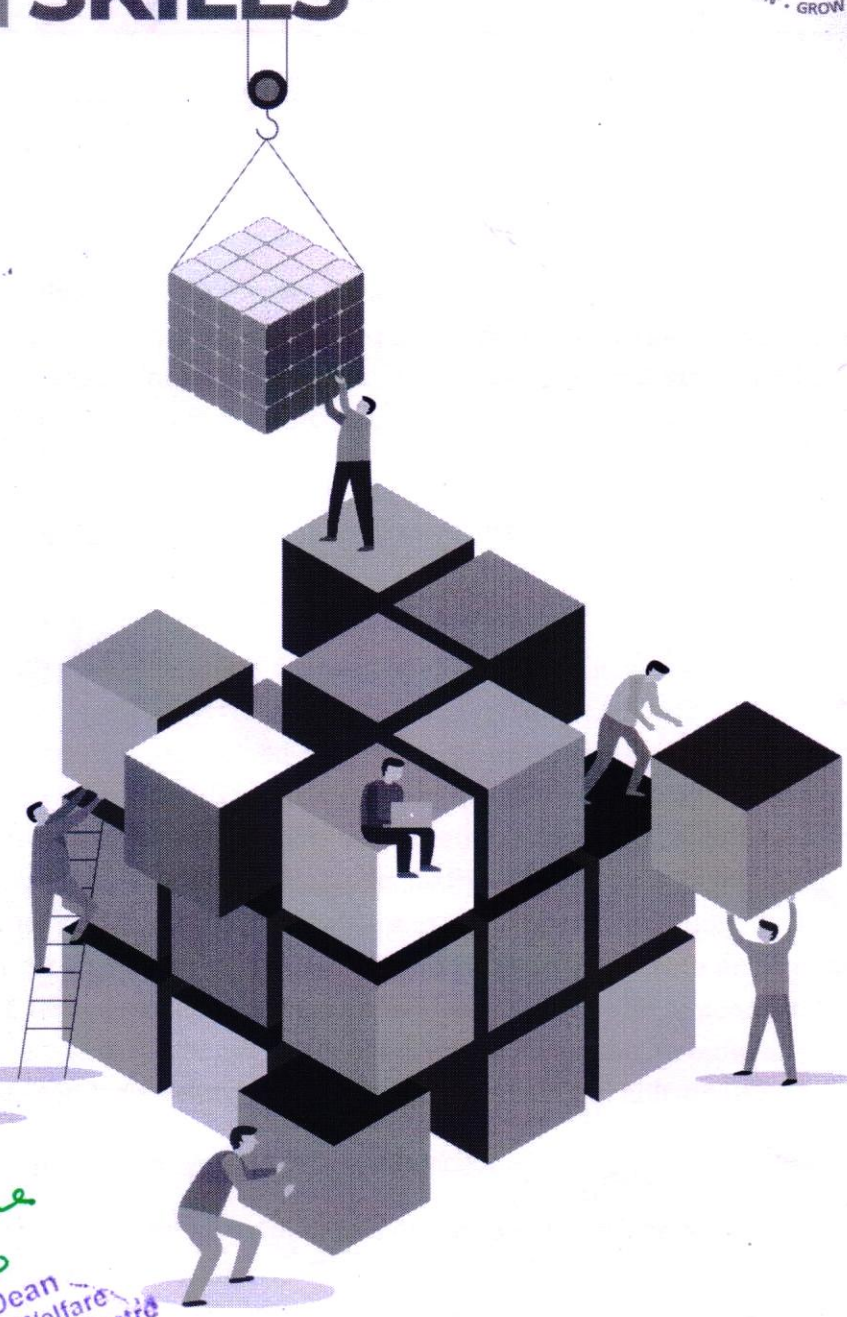

1.G.Karthikeyan: Sristi Foundation was founded by G.Karthikeyan, a psychologist born and raised in Pondicherry. He spent 15 years in an inclusive orphanage where disabled and non-disabled children lived together and helped each other out with their share of responsibilities. Soon, Karthik began to realize the differences between life of those with and those without intellectual disabilities upon witnessing incidents of irrational treatment; Karthik was moved to explore a way to unleash the potential of the intellectually disabled. On completion of his studies, Karthik returned to the same orphanage to serve as a director for more than nine years. He was refueled with the aim to find a way to train children and adults with intellectual disabilities to be more independent, to be taught a skill and enable them to generate their own income. To bring his vision to life he established the Sristi Foundation, to build an inclusive village where every person feels valued and can lead a dignified and holistic life.
