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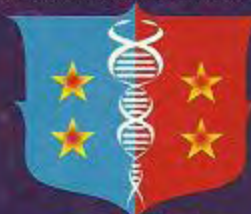

EVENT RULES



CULTURALS

Registration fee for cultural events is Rs. 800 per college.

No inflammable items are allowed for any of the events.

The number of prizes for a particular event will depend on the number of entries, i.e, a minimum of 5 entries is the requirement to offer 3 prizes and a minimum of 4 entries for 2 prizes.

The Cultural Committee reserves the right to alter the dates, time and occurrence of any event. In case of any dispute, all decisions made by the Cultural Committee will be considered final

All dance and music teams should register at the cultural desk at the time of their arrival.

Registration closes half an hour prior to the start of the particular event.

Cultural secretaries should be contacted in advance for instruments for the music events. Participants may use their own instruments. Damage to the provided instruments will result in penalization of the responsible teams.

The stage will not be open for practice.

Judges decisions are final.

Solo Singing

- Any number of participants per college.
- Time allotted is 3-4 minutes.
- Songs can be of any genre.

Music Competition

- One team per college, with 6-16 contestants.
- Time allotted per team is 20 minutes, including setup time.
- Pre-recorded music is **not** allowed.
- Songs can be in any language and genre and may be

acoustic/ a cappella

- There is a separate Rock Competition, so Rock Music is not allowed for this event.

Solo Dance

- Any number of participants per college.
- Time allotted is 4-5 minutes.
- All contestants should submit their music CDs at least 15 minutes prior to the event.
- Name of the participant, event name, contact number and college name should be written on the CD.

Indian Group Dance

- One team per college.
- Each team should have a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 16 participants.
- Time allotted is 7-10 minutes.
- All teams should submit their music CDs at least 15 minutes prior to the event.
- College name, event name and contact number of a representative should be written on the CD.
- Lots will be picked 15 minutes prior to the event.
- Usage of props is allowed.

Western Group Dance

- One team per college.
- Each team should have 8-10 participants.
- Time allotted is 7-10 minutes.
- All teams should submit their music CDs at least 15 minutes prior to the event.
- College name, event name and contact number of a representative should be written on the CD.

Duet Dance

- Any number of teams (of 2 participants each) per college.
- Time allotted is 5 minutes.

- All teams should submit their music CDs at least 15 minutes prior to the event.
- College name, event name and contact number of a representative should be written on the CD.

Adaptunes

- Any number of participants per college
- Genre of music will be changed repeatedly, and participants will be judged based on adaptability, spontaneity, entertainment and skill.

Fashion Show

- One team per college consisting of 10-25 participants.
- Time allotted per college is 15-20 minutes including set-up time.
- Participants may select their own theme.
- Props are allowed.
- All teams should submit their music CDs with their college name, event name and contact number of a representative at least 15 minutes prior to the event.

Variety Show

- One team per college, with a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 16 participants.
- Time allotted per team is 10 minute.
- Any form of entertainment may be performed.
- Props are allowed.

Rock Competition

- Cross-College bands are allowed for this event, and hence results of this event will not be considered for over-all prize.
- Maximum 7
- Time allotted per band is 15-20 minutes including set up (marks will be reduced if time is exceeded, time starts when the previous performer completely exceeds the stage)
- Vulgarities or profanities on stage will lead to automatic disqualification

- Original compositions and modified covers will score high
- Only English Rock Music will be entertained in this event.

ARTS AND MINOR EVENTS

Registration for Arts and Minor Events is Rs. 100 per college.

Art Events

- The events are Collage, Mehendi, Rangoli and Face Painting.
- Two participants per team, any number of teams per college for all the events.
- Participants must bring their own materials and instruments.
- All participants must register no later than 15 minutes prior to the start of the event.
- Rules for each event will be explained on arrival.

Eating Contest

- Any number of participants per college.
- Please puke only in the buckets provided.

Photography

- Any number of participants per college.
- Take photos throughout the course of the festival and submit them at the reception.
- Best Photos will be given prizes at the Valedictory function.

Creative Writing

- Any number of participants per team.
- Topic will be given on the spot.

LITERARY EVENTS

GENERAL RULES

Registration for Literary Events is Rs. 250 per college.
Foul language and/or vulgar displays will lead to disqualification. However,

innuendoes and euphemisms are appreciated.
English is preferred, Tamil is acceptable.

1) DUMB CHARADES

- 3 teams per college
- Each team must contain 3 participants.
- General rules apply – Spelling the words, Word Dropping, Mouthing and pointing to objects are not permitted.

2) TALK SHOW

- 3 teams containing 2 participants each per college.
- About 2 minutes preparation time will be given.
- Participants should introduce their characters for 1-2 min, followed by interaction with the host for about 3 minutes (5 minutes totally).

3) SHIPWRECK

- 3 participants per college.
- 2 minutes to state your case, followed by 3 minutes of questioning.
- 2 minutes preparation time will be given.

4) ADZAP

- 1 team per college, each team can have 6-10 participants.
- 5 minutes for each ad followed by 5 minutes of questioning by the judges.
- 5-10 minutes preparation time will be given.
- Props are allowed

5) JAM

- 3 participants per college.
- Regular JAM rules apply.

6) BLOCK & TACKLE

- 3 participants per college.
- 4 minutes per person.
- No preparation time will be given.

7) CINE QUIZ

- Any number of teams per college.

- Each team should have 3 participants.
- Quiz will include English, Hindi and Tamil films.

8) POT-POURRI

- The event includes Shadow Play, Three-headed Broadway Musical and Sit, Stand, Lie down
- 3 teams per college.
- Each team should have 3 members.

ACADEMIC EVENTS

Quiz

- Any number of teams per college.
- Max 2 per team (team can have 1 CCRI).
- Registration fee is Rs. 250 per team.
- Date: 13th March 2013
- Prelims – 10 am (60 questions – MCQ, Single Responses, Pictures)
- Finals – 2 pm

Prize Money - 1st Prize – Rs. 15,000

2nd Prize – Rs. 10,000

3rd Prize – Rs. 7500

Debate

- Registration fee is Rs 150 per team
- Max 3 team / per college
- Max 2 people per team
- Date: 15th March 2013

Prize Money: 1st Place -Rs. 2000

2nd Place -Rs. 1000

Best speaker- Rs. 500

Roleplay

- Registration fee is Rs.150 per team
- Any no. of teams teams/college
- 4-7 people per team
- Date: 15th March 2013
- Each team will be given a comedic medical scenario to enact and will be judged based on humor, as well as medical relevance.

Prize Money: 1st Place Rs. 3000
2nd Place Rs. 1500
Best Actor Rs. 500

SPORTS

1. **ONLY MEDICAL COLLEGES** can take part in sports and athletics events.

2. All games and sports will be conducted according to standard Rules and Regulations.

3. All teams should register at the Sports Desk in the Reception at their time of arrival.

4. Proper Uniforms with respective individual Chest Numbers & ID Cards are mandatory.

5. The participants must bring their own equipment.

6. Two sessions will be conducted - a Morning Session and an Evening Session.

7. The participating teams should be present at the respective venue 30 minutes prior to the start of the match.

8. Organizing Committee reserves the right to postpone, advance or cancel a fixture with prior notice.

9. Officials decision will be final.

Basketball

- 12 players max for boys and girls
- Registration fee for boys is Rs. 800 and for girls is Rs. 600

Hockey (boys only)

- Each college team can have a maximum of 14 players.

- Registration fee is Rs. 600

Volleyball (boys only)

- Maximum 12 players per college.
- Registration fee is Rs. 800

Football (boys only)

- Each college team can have a maximum of 16 players.
- Registration fee is Rs. 600

Throwball (girls only)

- Each team can have a maximum of 12 players
- Registration fee is Rs. 600

Tennis (boys only)

- There will be both singles and doubles
- Two players per team
- Registration per team is Rs. 400

Table Tennis

- There will be both singles and doubles
- Two players per team
- Registration per team is Rs. 400

Futsal (boys only)

- 8 players per college team (4+1 active, 3 substitutes)
- Registration fee is Rs. 500

Chess

- Maximum of 3 participants per college
- Registration fee Rs.200 per person

Athletics

- Events are 100m, 200m, Long Jump, Shot put and 4x100m

- Relay for both boys and girls
- Any number of participants from each college per event
- An athlete can participate in a maximum of 3 events (excluding relay)
- Each college can have only one team for boys relay and one team for girls relay.
- Registration for each athlete is Rs. 150

Hospitality

- Accommodation will be provided at a cost of Rs. 75/day
- Accommodation is provided on first come first serve basis.
- Lock and key, mattress, pillow, bucket and mug will be provided.
- Participants are requested to bring their college ID cards.
- Consumption of alcohol, narcotics, and smoking in the campus is strictly prohibited. No bags will be allowed inside the arena for rock show & outside beverages are not allowed for rockshow.
- Management is not responsible for any loss of valuables, luggage or any other belongings.
- Security deposit of Rs.2000 per college will be taken at the time of registration along with ID cards, and both will be returned at the end of the festival/when the college is leaving.

How to get here?

Location:

PIMS is in Kalapet, about 14 km North of downtown Puducherry on the East Coast Road, easily accessible by buses, taxis and auto-rickshaws.

By Air

Pondicherry now has its own Airport! However flights are limited so please check the listings in advance! The other nearest airport is at Chennai, which is about 160 km from Puducherry (about 3 hours by road)

By Train

Puducherry has a railway station, the nearest junction being Villupuram. The over-night trains form Chennai-Egmore and Chennai-Tambaram are best avoided.

By Bus

Puducherry is well connected by inter-city bus services with frequent buses from major cities close by. It is 3 hours from Chennai, 8 hours from Bangalore and 12 hours from Cochin.

By Car

Puducherry is served by the Tindivanam-Puducherry-Villupuram NH45A loop of the Chennai-Trichy National Highway NH45 and the scenic East Coast Road (ECR). It is about 3 hours from Chennai.
