

About ISCA

The Indian Science Congress Association (ISCA) owes its origin to the foresight and initiative of two British Chemists, namely, Professor J. L. Simonsen and Professor P.S. MacMahon. It occurred to them that scientific research in India might be stimulated if an annual meeting of research workers somewhat on the lines of the British Association for the Advancement of Science could be arranged.

The first meeting of the Congress was held from January 15-17, 1914 at the premises of the Asiatic Society, Calcutta, with the Honourable Justice Sir Asutosh Mukherjee, the then Vice-Chancellor of the Calcutta University, as President. There are 14 scientific sections functioning under ISCA. Scientists and research scholars can present their finding in the respective sections during the ISCA meet which is held regularly from January 3-7 of every year in the recent past. There are 29 ISCA chapters spread all over India. This year ISCA celebrates its centenary year and decided to celebrate it in a grand manner. Only 3 chapters situated in Coimbatore, Delhi and Vadodara have been selected among the 29 chapters for the year long celebrations.

The special feature of this Centenary Session is that for the first time in the history of the Indian Science Congress, the Hon'ble Prime Minister in office, Dr. Manmohan Singh, is the elected General President. The 100th ISCA meet will be held at Kolkata which is the Headquarters of ISCA.

About Coimbatore Chapter

This Chapter was inaugurated by His Excellency, Hon'ble Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, Former President of India on 3.5.2008 in our College premises. Dr. M. Aruchami, Executive Committee Member of ISCA is the Convener of this chapter. He is also the Secretary & Director of the host institution. This Chapter has continued its efforts to popularise science and foster a scientific temperament among the Scientists and Researchers by involving them in a series of Workshops/Seminars/Conferences/ Lectures organised every year, since its inception.

About the Host Institution

Coimbatore, "The Gold of KONGUNADU" is an evergrowing industrial city. The long felt need for one more college to meet the educational needs of this city was fulfilled on 12th August 1973, the day of inauguration of this College. The golden history of our college has been recorded with 39 years of excellence in man-making education and this temple of learning has been striving untiringly for the growth of Head, Hand and Heart of its devotees.

Our college is an autonomous institution affiliated to Bharathiar University, Coimbatore. It has been Re-accredited by NAAC with 'A' Grade Status securing 3.80 CGPA out of 4(95%). There are two milestones in the history of the College; one is "College with Potential for Excellence" (CPE) status awarded by UGC and the other is "Star College" status given by DBT, Government of India.

This Institute currently offers 20 UG, 13 PG, 11 M.Phil and 10 Ph.D courses. More than 3000 students are studying in our College inclusive of 219 scholars pursuing their research in various fields. So far 164 Ph.D scholars and 648 M.Phil scholars have been conferred degrees.

Focal Theme

The Theme of this Congress is "Science for Shaping the Future of India". Nowadays science plays a vital role in our day to day life. We are always in need of new scientific techniques for acquiring knowledge, increasing the yield of crops, producing power, curing the dreadful diseases, creating a clean and green environment, developing the infrastructural facilities, preventing the disasters, developing communication platforms, strengthing national security, etc.,

In the current scenario, the research activities taking place throughout India are not adequate when compared with the developed countries. Indian Science Congress Association would like to create the awareness on the importance of science and motivate the budding young researchers and the school children to do their research in a effective manner which will be helpful to make India a force to reckon with.

If people involve in research activities in their respective fields with sincerity and dedication, India will emerge as the mightiest country by 2020.

Programme

This Congress will be held as a Two days programme consisting of the Inauguration, Opening of a Science Exhibition, Sectional programmes, Children's Science Congress and the Valedictory Function.


