Two Week Capacity Building Programme for Young Faculty Members in Social Sciences (Sponsored by ICSSR, New Delhi)

INTRODUCTION

Social science research is characterized by the diversity of theoretical perspectives, methodological strategies, data collection practices and analysis techniques. This has made it always necessary to provide training and orientation on a continuing basis to researchers to equip them with advanced methodological skills. It has been observed that many researchers could not produce research works of high quality because they are either not in touch with the latest research tools and techniques or do not have proper orientation to use the traditional research methods efficiently. The problem has further been aggravated by lack of opportunities for the social researchers to refine their methodological skills and to get insight in fresh areas of research in their respective fields. On the other hand the rapid advancement of knowledge in all disciplines of social sciences has made research an activity of solving problems, which add new dimensions and generalizations on the basis of gathered empirical evidences. Recognizing this need, Department of Politics and International Studies, School of Social Sciences, Pondicherry University, Puducherry is organizing a Two-Week capacity Building Programme for Social Science Young Faculty members from 18th October, 2018 to 31st October 2108 sponsored by Indian Council of Social Science Research, New Delhi.

The objectives of this programme are to develop capacity for conceptualizing and writing research proposals; to enhance skills to prepare an appropriate research design, including conducting a literature review, formulating research questions and hypotheses, collection of information and analysis; to enhance capacity for writing a research paper for publication; to develop the capacity for planning and writing a book and to develop the capacity for grant applications. The programme also strives to highlight some emerging philosophical and methodological issues emerging in social science research inculcating discussions on formation and selection of a research problem; design of research; sampling techniques; tools of research; collection of data; analysis of data; interpretation and discussion of results and report writing. In addition to enabling the participants to select and make use of suitable research methods appropriate research tools and to analyze their research questions with appropriate analysis of data in their research.
