The Department of Sanskrit, Pondicherry University is going to organize A Two-Day National Seminar on "इक्कीसवीं शताब्दी की संस्कृत-साहित्य-रचनाधर्मिता का मूल्याङ्कन" (21st Century's writing trends in Sanskrit Literature-A Critical Assessment), 07th 8th August, 2019 in collaboration with Sahitya Akademi, New Delhi, Prabhat Research Foundation and Renaissance Universal.

Starting from the Vedas till Neo-Globalized-Post-Modern era Sanskrit upholds the Intellectual Traditions for preserving knowledge, supporting human life and society. Sanskrit Literary Writings have been paying pivotal role in enhancing human intellect and society. Sanskrit Literary Writings can be classified into two major parts. One is Kāvya and another is Kāvyaśāstra. The Kāvya deals reality of the universe whereas Kāvyaśāstra reveals scientific structure of the Kāvya. The Kāvya as a mirror of Society represents and reconstructs the Society whereas Kāvyaśāstra as a science of Kāvya critically reveals overall structure of the Kāvya for developing scientific, critical and rationalist knowledge so that advanced eco-friendly sustainable society could be developed.

The main objectives of the seminar is to critically assess -21st Century's writing trends of Kāvya as well as Kāvyašāstra. It would also try to review overall modern writing trends in Sanskrit Literature in global prospective, whether modern Poetry trends and literary Theories are serving the needs of society in enhanced manner or something more is required to contribute in the writings so that Sanskrit Literary Writings would able to serve not only the need of the society but it would also able to serve as a universal role model for other literature and literary criticisms.
